THIS PERMIT OBLIGATES THE APPLICANT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

1. At the option of the Drain Commissioner, deposit cash, performance bond, or a check in the sum of \$ _____ acceptable to the Drain Commissioner to guarantee the faithful performance of the conditions of the permit.
2. Save harmless the Drain Commissioner, against any and all claims for damages and losses of any kind, including actual attorney fees, arising from operations covered by this permit and upon request, furnish proof of insurance coverage naming Monroe County, the Monroe County Drain Commissioner and the _____ Drainage District as an additional insured for the term of this permit for One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) general liability combined single limit coverage for bodily injury and property damage arising from operations conducted pursuant to this permit.
3. Give telephone or written notice to the Drain Commissioner at least 48 hours prior to commencement of operation covered by this permit.
4. In any and all operations under this permit, meet all applicable requirements of the Drain Commissioner's Specifications and Supplemental Specifications as set forth on the reverse side of this application.
5. Additional conditions: _____
6. Take, provide and maintain all necessary precautions to prevent injury or damage to persons and property from operations covered by this permit and use safety devices which are in accordance with applicable Federal and State Requirements.
7. Upon request of the Drain Commissioner, immediately remove, cease operations and surrender this permit or alter or relocate, at applicant's expense, the facility for which this permit is granted. Upon failure to do so, the Drain Commissioner shall take the necessary action and the applicant shall reimburse the Drain Commissioner for its costs in doing the same.
8. Nothing in this permit shall be construed to grant any rights whatsoever to any public utilities whatsoever except as to the consent herein specifically given, not to impair anywise any existing right granted in accordance with the constitution or laws of this State.
9. Give notice to public utilities in accordance with Act 53, PA 1974 and comply with all other provisions of said act. Call "Miss Dig" at least 48 hours before excavating by dialing 1-800-482-7171.
10. Promptly reimburse the Drain Commissioner for any Inspection costs incurred as a result of activities covered by this permit, when applicable.
11. Comply with the requirements of Part 91, SESC, P.A. 451 of 1994 as amended, controlling soil erosion and sedimentation.

SUPPLEMENTAL SPECIFICATIONS:

1. Permit: The individual in charge of the work shall have the permit together with approved plans or sketches in his possession on the job at all times.
2. Trees: No trees shall be removed without the prior approval of the Drain Commissioner and, if necessary, the abutting property owner. Trees damaged by the Contractor shall be neatly trimmed and repaired in an approved manner.
3. Depth of cover: Underground utilities shall be installed with not less than five (5) feet of cover below the bottom elevation of a drain.
4. Work days: No work within the drain right-of-way will be permitted on Saturdays, Sundays or Holidays without the express permission of the Drain Commissioner unless permission has been granted prior to construction.
5. Seeding: All disturbed areas of vegetation shall be smoothly graded, seeded and mulched in accordance with current Michigan Department of Transportation Specifications and the soil erosion control permit.
6. Prosecution of the work: Restoration and clean-up work shall be carried on concurrent with other items of work and completed in a timely manner. Excessive delay in undertaking and completing right-off-way restoration will not be permitted. All restoration shall result in a condition that is equal to or better than that which existed prior to the start of the work.

NOTE: This permit does not relieve applicant from meeting any applicable requirements of law or of other public bodies or agencies.
